

INFORMATION ON THE TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

This page describes how to manage the site in relation to the processing of personal data of users who consult it. This is an information note that is also provided pursuant to Article 13 of the Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 - Code regarding the protection of personal data to those who interact with the web services of the site, accessible electronically from the address:

corresponding to the homepage of the official website.

The information is provided only for the NEPHOS site and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links. The information is also based on the Recommendation n.2 / 2001 that the European authorities for data protection

Cookies

What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by the user send to his terminal - computers, laptops, tablets, smartphones, etc. - where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites on the occasion of the next visit by the same user. By browsing this site, you will only receive cookies sent directly from our site. In this regard, and for personal purposes, gathered in the Group established by Article 29 of Directive no. 95/46 / EC, adopted on 17 May 2001 to identify certain minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online, and, in particular, the methods, timing and nature of the information that the data controllers must provide to the users when they connect to web pages, regardless of the purpose of the link. The Recommendation and a summary description of its purposes are reported in other pages of this site.

THE "OWNER" OF THE TREATMENT

Following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may / may not be processed. The "owner" of their treatment is NEPHOS Srl, which is based in Strada 1 palazzo E2, 20090 Assago (MI).

DATA PROCESSING PLACE

The treatments connected to the web services of this site take place at the aforementioned NEPHOS Srl.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes IP addresses or names domains of the computers used by users connecting to the site, the addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response , the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site: except for this eventuality, the data on web contacts do not persist for more than seven days.

Data provided voluntarily by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message. Specific summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the site prepared for particular services on request.

Cookies

What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by the user send to his terminal - computers, laptops, tablets, smartphones, etc. - where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites on the occasion of the next visit by the same user. By browsing this site, you will only receive cookies sent directly from our site. In this regard, and for the purpose of this provision, two macro-categories are therefore identified: "technical" cookies and "profiling" cookies. As far as cookies are concerned, the user is informed that only technical cookies called "analytics" are used in this site to statistically analyze visits to the site and technical navigation or session cookies. They are exclusively for statistical purposes and collect information in aggregate form and in particular the analytics cookies used on this site are those of Google, based on javascript ga.js. The browsing or session cookies, on the other hand, allow the user easy navigation. No personal user data is acquired by the site in this regard.

We do not use cookies to transmit information of a personal nature, nor are persistent c.d.cookies of any kind used, or systems for tracking users. The use of c.d. Session cookies (which are not stored permanently on the user's computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to allow safe browsing and efficient site. I c.d. Session cookies used on this site avoid the use of other technologies that could compromise the privacy of users' browsing and do not allow the acquisition of personal identification data.

HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES

Each browser has its own management of cookies, therefore we recommend that you follow the relevant guides.

OPTIONAL DATA SUPPLY

Apart from that specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data contained in the request forms to NEPHOS or indicated in contacts with the Office to request the newsletter, information material or of other communications. Failure to provide such data may make it impossible to obtain what has been requested.

For the sake of completeness, it should be noted that in some cases (not subject to the ordinary management of this site) the Authority may request information and information pursuant to Article 153 of the Code regarding the protection of personal data, for the purposes of monitoring the processing of personal data. In these cases the answer is mandatory under penalty of administrative sanction.

TREATMENT METHODS

Personal data are processed with automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PEOPLE

The subjects to whom the personal data refer have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of the same data and to know its content and origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating, or rectification (article 7 of the Code regarding the protection of personal data).

According to the same article, you have the right to request cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, and to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, to their processing.
